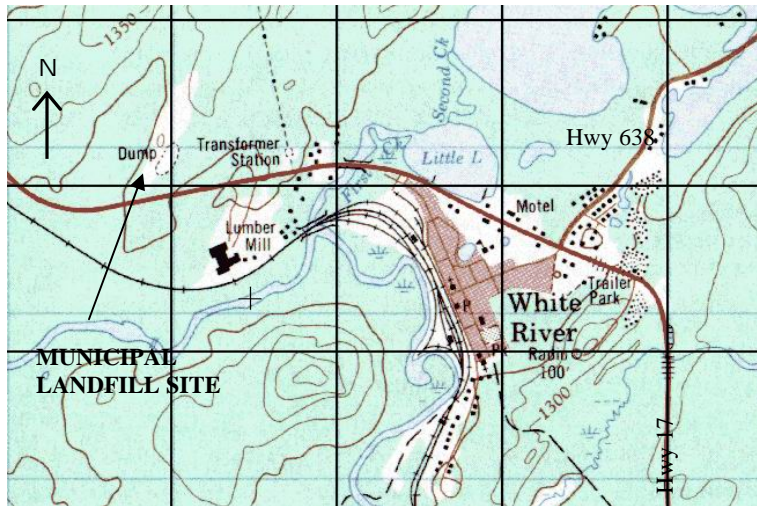


THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE RIVER

NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING PROCESS

The Township of White River's municipal waste disposal site accepts solid, non-hazardous industrial, commercial and domestic waste produced by residents of the Township of White River and by the Pic Mobert (North and South) First Nations. Allowing for Obatanga and White Lake Provincial Parks, the municipal waste disposal site serves an estimated total population of 1,200. In operation since 1970, the waste disposal site is located on Crown land and currently operates under a Certificate of Approval issued by the Ministry of the Environment.

To address Fill Beyond Approved Limits (FBAL) as well as inadequate waste disposal capacity, it is the Township's preference to expand the waste disposal site. In order to meet Environmental Assessment Act requirements, the Township must review methods to accommodate the FBAL and the required disposal volume.



The above undertaking is subject to the Provincial Environmental Screening Process for Waste Management Projects. An Open House information session will be held on October 6, 2011 from 6pm to 8pm and on October 7, 2011 from 10am to 12pm and you are invited to attend and to provide your comments.
