



**NOTICE OF COMPLETION  
SCHEDULE C MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT**

**NORTHERN AVENUE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS**

The City of Sault Ste. Marie (City) has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) for improvements to the Northern Avenue corridor.

The MCEA was initiated to investigate alternatives to improve the efficiency of Northern Avenue since the City's 2015 Transportation Master Plan (TMP) identified the corridor as a candidate for a potential road diet. The TMP also identified that the potential extension of Northern Avenue to Black Road may help to improve road network efficiency. In conjunction with these potential improvements, the City identified the opportunity to integrate improvements to the access/egress of the P-Patch subdivision.

The study was conducted in accordance with the approved requirements for a Schedule C project under the MCEA. The study included public consultation, contact with Indigenous communities and government review agencies and the evaluation of alternatives. During the course of the study, Public Information Centres were held on June 22, 2016 and September 26, 2017 to present findings and receive input from interested parties.

The Environmental Study Report (ESR) documents the MCEA process followed throughout the study. By this notice, the ESR is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period as required by the MCEA. Marie, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change (Minister) make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act, which addresses individual environmental assessments. A Part II Order request must be made in writing to the Minister at the address below and received within 30 days of this Notice of Completion being published. A copy of the Part II Order request must also be sent to the City of Sault Ste. Marie at the address below. If a Part II Order request is not received by August 7, 2018, 2018 this project may proceed as presented.
